

SYCAMORE LAKES PARK FISHING RULES

You MUST be in possession of a current EA rod license

Barbless hooks only rig checks will be carried out by the bailiff

Fishing is from Dawn till Dusk. Strictly no fishing in the dark hours

Unhooking mats MUST be always used for Carp

No rods to be left unattended at ANY time

Any litter to be disposed of in the bins provided (main car park)

Fish from numbered pegs only no stalking

No self-hooking devices magic twig or magic wand for example

No braided mainline. Spod and Marker rods can be braided

Dogs are allowed however; they must be kept on a lead and any mess cleaned up.

All children under the age of 14 MUST be accompanied by an adult.

All nets, unhooking mats, weigh slings MUST be disinfectant dipped before you start to fish

No nuts of any description, however nut-based boilies are fine

Any intoxicated or anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated with the potential of being asked to leave site

No fixed rigs, checks will be randomly carried out by bailiffs

Bait boats are allowed, however please respect your fellow Anglers and keep within your own swim boundaries

All fish to be return to the water in a safe and timely manner

Specimen lake rules

A minimum of 42-inch landed net must be used

12lb minimum breaking strain line to be used

Anglers to be in possession of fish care kit to treat any wounds

No reserving pegs on Specimen Lake.

Large unhooking mats / cradles to be used

Fish care is our priority get your camera, scales, unhooking mat ready before lifting the carp out of the water.

360 rig is not allowed Spinner rigs/Ronnie rigs are fine
